Bungay's Street Markets have a great reputation with both traders and visitors and the three that the Bungay Chamber of Trade already run are always over-subscribed and regularly attract well in excess of 10,000 visitors. Alongside the Market, Sustainable Bungay will co-ordinate a range of 'fringe' activities - from kids stuff to composting demonstrations!

**Who's Organising it?** Sustainable Bungay, a 'Transition Town' group formed to address the issues of climate change and declining oil reserves, in conjunction with the Bungay Chamber of Trade who have years of experience running Bungay Street Markets.

**Who Should Attend?** Local food producers, retailers, renewable energy installers, green builders and building suppliers, campaigning groups with a focus on sustainability, crafts using recycled or reused materials - in fact anyone who's committed to sustainable living and high quality products.
